The Solution: Doc-To-Help

Doc-to-Help (a.k.a. D2H)

- Work in Word
- Generate all outputs:
 - In-product help (CHM file)
 - Website (HTML files)
 - Downloadable (PDFs)
- Easy to work with



Word Best Practices

WORD HEADING STYLES

- Used for:
 - Page breaks
 - Table of contents
 - Related topics / navigation
- Limited to Headings 1-5

- Avoid headings with no text
- Use a "fake" heading
 - Same look and feel
 - Not referenced by D2H during output generation
